Action Items

1. **Approval of KEEP Evaluation Documents**
Tim asked that the board adopt the district leader and building leader evaluation forms from the Kansas Educator Evaluation Protocol (KEEP) as a pilot evaluation for the 2013-14 school year. This form will be used to evaluate each special education administrator once this year.

ACTION

Ed Courtney made a motion to approve the Kansas Educator Evaluation Protocol (KEEP) for use as the Keystone administrator evaluation tool for the 2013-2014 school year as a pilot project, as presented. Scott Gibson seconded and motion carried 6-0.

Discussion Items

1. **Keystone Office Staff** – Tim explained that we are down two positions in the business office and plans to operate with three, not four people for the remainder of the school year. Tim reviewed other possible changes and shifts in funding from special education to the service center.
2. **Potential Budget Cuts** – Tim and board members shared ideas regarding budget cuts. Tim will bring further information back to the board next month.
3. **Interlocal Expansion** – The Leavenworth special education cooperative is considering disbanding or reorganizing. Tim explained that Pleasant Ridge Schools (Easton) has asked that we discuss the possibility of bringing them into Keystone if the breakup occurs. During the superintendent council meeting,

members were open to the idea of the board beginning those discussions. Tim shared preliminary numbers for the board's consideration. Superintendents and the Keystone board are not interested in a change unless it keeps our districts from incurring any additional expenses. Tim will bring more information back next month to present to the board, including estimated costs to run Easton's program and a preliminary agreement.

4. Items From Board Members

Tim will complete his self-evaluation and have it to the board by January 8th. The board agreed to have their director evaluations completed and emailed to Ron Langston by January 15th. The date of the January board meeting is the 22nd.
