Position Overview



Keystone Learning Services – An education consortium that provides a variety of programming services to area school districts. Examples include: special services, alternative high school, cooperative purchasing, and Parents as Teachers.

Parents as Teachers – Currently 17 school districts contract PAT services from Keystone. We serve over 400 families in NE Kansas.

Parent Educators –

- Must attend week-long training and pass certification. Dates for training: August 14 – 18 in Kansas City, Kansas
- Must have reliable transportation
- Must be able to attend required staff meetings and in-services
- Must have flexible work hours: mornings/afternoons/evenings
- Mileage is paid from your home to visits and meetings
- Time on the road is paid for
- Must be able to maintain a home office with space to store supplies & materials
- Keystone will provide a personal computer and printer
- Must have access to internet service at home or ability to go to another source

Starting wage –

- \$13.50 - \$14.50 per hour with 4-year degree in the field or related field
- \$13.75 - \$14.75 per hour with masters degree in the field or related field

Position Specifics (2 openings) –

- 21 hours per week serving families in Eudora

Benefits –

- Seven paid holidays, 1 week vacation (first year), 2 days personal leave, and 12 days sick leave (prorated from start date)
- KPERs (state retirement fund) required if work more than 20 hours
