PROCEDURE UPDATE

Two-Step Verification for Email - Update by November 1st

Step 1: Sign into your Chrome browser with your Keystone credentials.

Step 2: Then use this link https://myaccount.google.com/signinoptions/twosv

Step 3: Follow the link to the two-step verification setup page of your Google account (password may be required). (If two-step verification is already turned on you will see a message indicating that and you may log out)

Step 4: If it has not been activated, there will be a button to enter the phone number on which you want to receive the notification (cell phone number). Enter that number on this page.

Step 5: If done properly you will receive a code via text that you must enter on the web page.
